AND WHEREAS The Kamloops Indian Band has passed the Taxation Amendment By-law, the Property Rates, Classification and Miscellaneous Amendment By-law, and various other by-laws related to the assessment and taxation of land within the reserves, pursuant to Section 83 of the Indian Act.

AND WHEREAS It is necessary to adopt a further by-law for the purposes of implementing the Kamloops Indian Band's taxation system.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

That the Chief and Council of the Kamloops Indian Band enacts the following By-law pursuant to the Indian Act, and in particular Section 83(1)(a), (a.1), and (g) of the Indian Act.

1. SHORT TITLE

This by-law may be cited as the 1994 Property Rates By-law.

Pursuant to Section 7 of the Kamloops Indian Band Property Taxation By-law, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached to and forms part of the By-law.
