



BE IT KNOWN that this by-law, entitled "the Rates By-law", which forms SCHEDULE "A" of the Taxation By-laws, passed by the Chief and Council and approved by the Minister on July 30, 1993, that being a by-law to establish by by-law a system on the reserve lands of the Adams Lake Indian Band, for the fair and equitable taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including reserves, is hereby enacted as by-law 1994/95-001, by the Chief and Council of the Adams Lake Indian Band.

Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Adams Lake Indian Band, held at the Adams Lake Indian Band Administration Office, Chase, British Columbia, this 18th day of May, 1994. A quorum consists of four (4) Band Councillors.
