## BY-LAW NO. \_\_ H AISLA NATION RATES BY-LAW

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, 1985, c.1-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matter arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Haisla Nation enacted the *Haisla Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law* on July 25, 2006 and the *Haisla Nation Property Assessment and Taxation Amendment By-law* on August 23, 2007;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.


1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the *Haisla Nation Rates By-law 2011*.
2. Pursuant to Section 11 of the *Haisla Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law*, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2011 Rates By-law.

**THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by the Haisla Nation Council on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 2011, at Haisla Nation Council Administration Building in the Province of British Columbia.**

**Quorum for the Haisla Nation Council is 5 Council Members and 1 Chief Councillor.**


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
