TLA-O-QUI-AHT FIRST NATIONS

2004 RATES BY-LAW

BY-LAW NO. 2004-01

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1) of the Indian Act, the Council of a Band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interest in land including the rights to occupy, possess or use lands within the boundaries of a Reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nations enacted the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nations Property Tax By-law on August 9, 1995;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular to Section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

1. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nations 2004 Rates By-law.
2. Pursuant to Section 11 of the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nations Property Tax By-law, the rates of each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached and forms part of the By-law.

THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Chief and Council of the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nations at a duly convened meeting held on the 7TH day of May, 2004. OCTOBER
