AND WHEREAS: the Council of the Shuswap Indian Band enacted the Shuswap Indian Band Taxation and Assessment Bylaw on March 9, 1992;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED: that the followling bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Shuswap Indian Band 1998 Rates Bylaw.
- Pursuant to section 24 of the Shuswap Indian Band Taxation Bylaw, the rates for each class of property shall be inaccordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and borms part of the 1998 Rates Bylaw.

This bylaw is hereby enacted by the Council of the Shuswap Indian Band at a duly convened meeting held on the 14th day of May, 1998.
