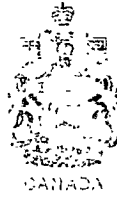

Prescribed Tax Rates
For the Taxation Year 1992

BE IT KNOWN that this By-law entitled "the Rates Bylaw" which forms part of the Taxation By-law passed by Chief and Council and approved by the Minister March 9th, 1992, that being a by-law to establish by by-law a system on the reserve lands of the Columbia Lake Band for the fair and equitable taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land including the rights to occupy, possess or use lands within the boundaries of the reserves is hereby enacted as by-law 1992-T02 by the Chief and Council of the Columbia Lake Band at a duly convened meeting of the said council on the 15th day of May 1992.
