

BE IT KNOWN that this bylaw entitled Rates Bylaw which forms part of the *Taxation Bylaw* passed by Chief and Council, and approved by the Minister on 1992, March 9th, that being a bylaw, to establish, via bylaw, a system on the reserve lands of the St. Mary's Indian Band for the fair and equitable taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including the rights to occupy, possess or use lands within the boundaries of the reserves is hereby enacted as Rates Bylaw 2001-Yr09 by the Chief and Council of the St. Mary's Indian Band.


