**SHXWHÁ:Y VILLAGE**  
**PROPERTY ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION BY-LAW**  
**AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2006 - 03**

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. I-5, the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Shxwhá:y Village enacted the *Shxwhá:y Village Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw* on June 24, 2004;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Shxwhá:y Village enacted the *Shxwhá:y Village Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw, Amendment by-law 2004-02* on September 30, 2004;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted for the purpose of amending certain provisions of the *Shxwhá:y Village Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw* as amended by the *Shxwhá:y Village Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw, Amendment by-law 2004-2* as hereinafter provided.

**SHORT TITLE**

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the *Shxwhá:y Village Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw, Amendment By-law No. 2006-03*.

**AMENDMENT**

2. The *Shxwhá:y Village Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw* enacted on June 24, 2004 is amended as follows:
  - (a) in subsection 6(j), by deleting the “.” and replacing it with “; and”,
  - (b) in subsection 6, by adding the following exemption from taxation as subsection 6(k):  
“6(k) any interest in land granted to or held by the City of Chilliwack.”


**SEVERANCE OF SECTIONS**




**COMING INTO FORCE**


