**MATSQUI FIRST NATION**

**BYLAW NO. 2005-02**

**MATSQUI FIRST NATION RATES BYLAW**

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters rising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Matsqui First Nation has duly and properly enacted the Matsqui First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaws;

NOW BE IT THEREBY RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.


**1.** This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Matsqui First Nation Rates Bylaw No. 2005-02.

**2.** Pursuant to Part 3 of the Matsqui First Nation Property Taxation Bylaw, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" for properties on Matsqui Indian Reserve Nos. 2 and 4. Schedule "A" is attached and forms part of the Matsqui First Nation Rates Bylaw No. 2005-02.

**3.** Pursuant to the provisions of the Property Assessment and Taxation (Right of Way) Regulations, the taxation rate to be applied to New Westminster Land District, TRACKAGE MI 4.20 TO MI 4.40 MATSQUI RESERVE #1 and New Westminster Land District, RW 100 FT CORRIDOR MI 4.20 TO MILE 4.40 MATSQUI RESERVE 31, being all interests in land held by the Canadian Pacific Railway Co. located on the reserve lands of the Matsqui First Nation, shall be the maximum rate allowed under the said regulations.

This bylaw is hereby enacted by Council at a duly convened meeting held on the 2 day of August, 2005.
