WHEREAS the Stoney Tribal Council is empowered to act for and on behalf of the people of the Bearspaw, Chiniki and Wesley Bands; and

WHEREAS the Stoney Tribal Council has met in quorum at a duly convened meeting on the 17th day of April, 2007; and

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.1-5, the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Stoney First Nation enacted the Stoney Property Tax Bylaw on July 9, 1992;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Stoney First Nation Tax Rates Bylaw 2007.
- 2. Pursuant to section 11 of the Stoney Property Tax Bylaw, the rate of tax applied against the assessed value of property shall be:
 - (a) for non residential

1.40%

(b) for machinery and equipment

0.70%

Proper books and records will be kept in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and will be open to Department staff at all reasonable times for review.
