

ANNUAL BUDGET BY-LAW, 1989
Being a By-Law Respecting
The Budget and Rate of Taxation for 1989

WHEREAS SECTION 83 (1) OF THE INDIAN ACT, R.S.C., 1985, c. I-5, AS AMENDED, EMPOWERS THE COUNCIL OF A BAND TO MAKE BY-LAWS RESPECTING TAXATION;

AND WHEREAS THE COUNCIL OF THE STURGEON LAKE BAND OF INDIANS DID ENACT THE STURGEON LAKE BAND OF INDIANS -- BY-LAW RESPECTING TAXATION AND BUSINESS LICENSING, PURSUANT TO SECTION 83 OF THE INDIAN ACT, WHICH BY-LAW WAS APPROVED BY THE MINISTER OF INDIAN AFFAIRS AND NORTHERN DEVELOPMENT BY DECLARATION DATED THE 17TH DAY OF FEBRUARY 1987, PURSUANT TO SECTION 83 OF THE INDIAN ACT;

AND WHEREAS SECTION 83 (2) OF THE INDIAN ACT REQUIRES THAT AN EXPENDITURE MADE OUT OF MONEYS RAISED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 83 MUST BE SO MADE UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF A BY-LAW OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BAND;

AND WHEREAS SECTION 21 OF THE STURGEON LAKE BAND OF INDIANS -- BY-LAW RESPECTING TAXATION AND BUSINESS LICENSING, REQUIRES THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE BAND PASS, IN EACH YEAR, A BUDGET BY-LAW;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE STURGEON LAKE BAND OF INDIANS ENACTS AS A BYLAW THEREOF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. THE RATE OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED ON ALL ASSESSED PROPERTY SHOWN ON THE ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE 1989 TAX YEAR IS 25 MILLS, AND THE ASSESSED VALUE OF PROPERTY AND ESTIMATED RECEIPTS ARE MORE PARTICULARLY SET FORTH IN SCHEDULE "A" ATTACHED TO THIS BY-LAW.
- THE ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES ARE TO BE APPLIED TO THE STURGEON LAKE BAND OF INDIANS ARENA/RECREATION PROGRAMS FOR THE TAXATION YEAR, 1989, WHICH ARE MORE PARTICULARLY SET FORTH IN SCHEDULE "B" ATTACHED TO THIS BY-LAW.
