



Purpose:	White Bear First Nations Tax Rates By-law 2005
Date	May 9, 2005
<p>That pursuant to a Resolution passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the White Bear First Nations ("White Bear") at the office of White Bear on the 9th day of May, 2005 the Council of White Bear have authorized the following:</p> <p>WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the <i>Indian Act</i>, R.S.C. 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose; and</p> <p>WHEREAS the Council of the White Bear First Nations enacted the White Bear First Nations Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw on April 23, 1998; and</p> <p>WHEREAS the Council has caused an assessment to be made of all property shown on the assessment roll for 2005; and</p> <p>NOW BE IT THEREBY RESOLVED that the following bylaw be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the <i>Indian Act</i> and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the White Bear First Nations 2005 Tax Rates Bylaw. 2. Pursuant to section 11 of the White Bear First Nations Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached. <p>This bylaw is hereby enacted by Council at a duly convened meeting held on the 9th day of May, 2005.</p>	














