PROPERTY TAX ESKASONI FIRST NATION RATES BY-LAW 2020

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Eskasoni First Nation (also known as the Eskasoni Band) enacted the Eskasoni First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law on April 24th, 2012;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Eskasoni First Nation Rates By-law 2020
- Pursuant to Section 13 of the Eskasoni First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law 2012, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2020 Rates By-law.

THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council on the 2 day of October, 2020, at Eskasoni, in the Province of Nova Scotia.
