SUCKER CREEK FIRST NATION

RATES BY-LAW 2021

WHEREAS pursuant to the *indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, 1985, c.I-S, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of texation for local purposes of land, or inferests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHBRBAS the Council of the Sucker Creek First Nation (also known as the Sucker Creek Band) enacted the Sucker Creek First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law, 2011 on May 4, 2011 and approved by the Minister on December 20, 2011;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- 1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Sucker Creek First Nation Rates By-law 2021.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 54 of the Sucker Creek First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law, 2011, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2021 Rates By-law.
